VII. Discussion

A. Proposed Attendance Accounting Formula

- During the meeting, it was discussed that Apportionment funding may experience an approximate 2% decrease due to the compressed calendar. One option suggested was to reduce lab hours down to 3. Another proposal was to increase Lab Units by $\frac{1}{2}$. Hours can be pushed up to 4.5 and will still be paid for by the state. The committee agreed to continue to monitor the situation and to reconvene for further discussion as needed. The new formula is set to be in effect for 2026.

B. Noncredit to Credit Pathways

- Committee continued discussing noncredit to credit pathways and agreed to create better clarity behind the thrust of this work. All 3 institutions will meet to expand on options and opportunities for our students. Cypress and Fullerton College agreed to put forward specific disciplines as models for development with Cypress suggesting Healthcare and Fullerton suggesting Computer Information Systems. More discussion will follow and DCCC will continue to facilitate any progress made in this area.
