#### VIII. Discussion

### A. Cypress College Local General Education Pattern as voted at Senate

 Cypress College's Academic Senate approved an amended version of the local General Education (GE) pattern without returning the proposal to the Curriculum Committee for further review. The DCCC Chair informed the committee that the Local General Education pattern must be included on the DCCC agenda; otherwise, it will not move forward.

## B. AP 4025 – Philosophy and Criteria for Associate Degree. General Education and Bachelor's Degree

• Discussion included a recommendation to remove the reference to the baccalaureate degree pilot program. However, further review is required to

determine its continued applicability. Updates to Title V have also incorporated additional information regarding the program, necessitating further examination. AP 4025 will be brought back for action in January.

### C. AP 4100 – Graduation Requirements for Degrees and Certificates

 No feedback was offered, and AP 4100 will also be brought back for action in January

### D. Common Course Numbering Workgroup Update

- Three meetings have been conducted to date. Twenty systems have been engaged and ranked to assess CCN impact. Initial tasks include utilizing Banner for course input and scheduling data, followed by configuring prerequisites and equivalencies. Scheduling adjustments are expected to be minimal. Awaiting Ellucian updates in mid-January, after which in-house testing will commence. Discussion on staff overtime for course and system updates is ongoing and will be formally agendized at the Vice Presidents' Council
