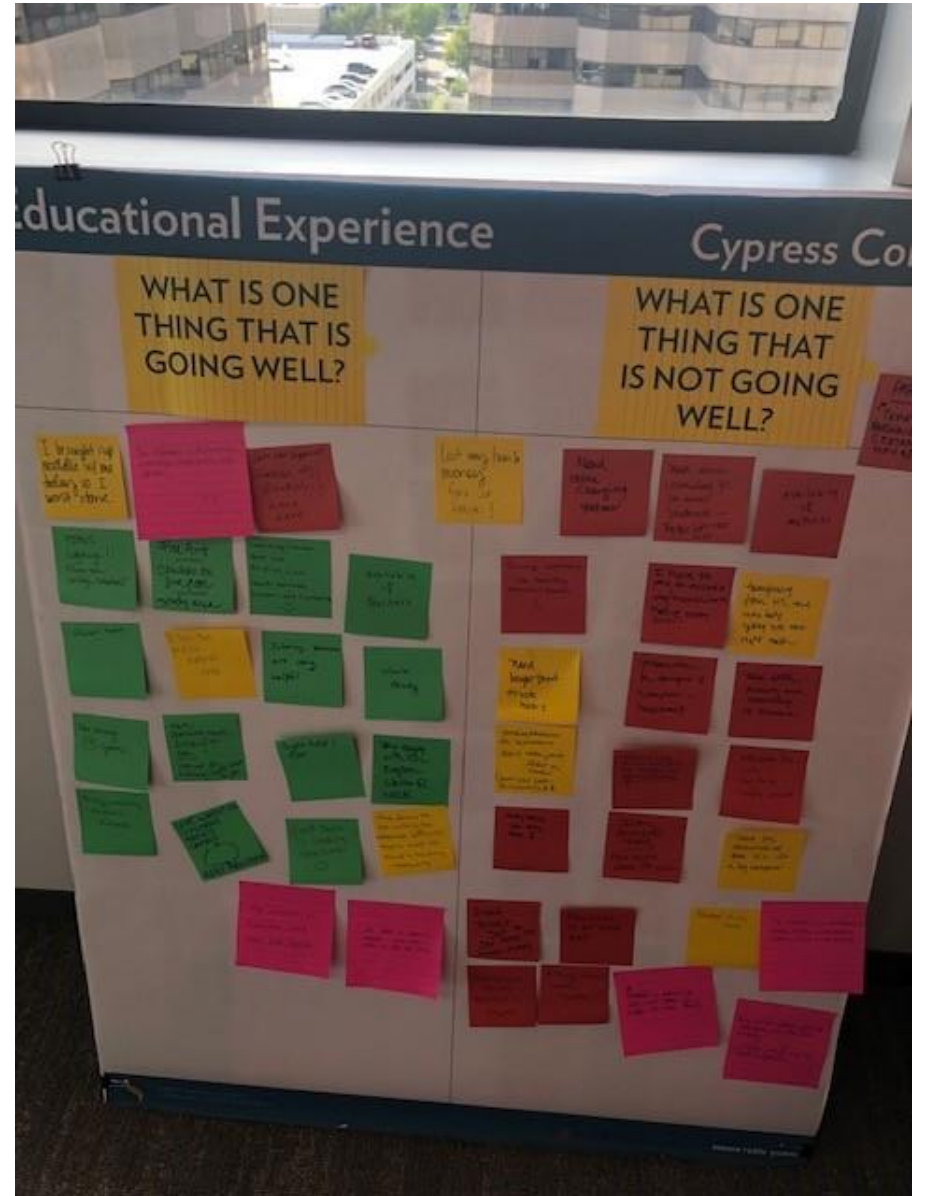

## Obstacles Keeping you from Reaching Goals:

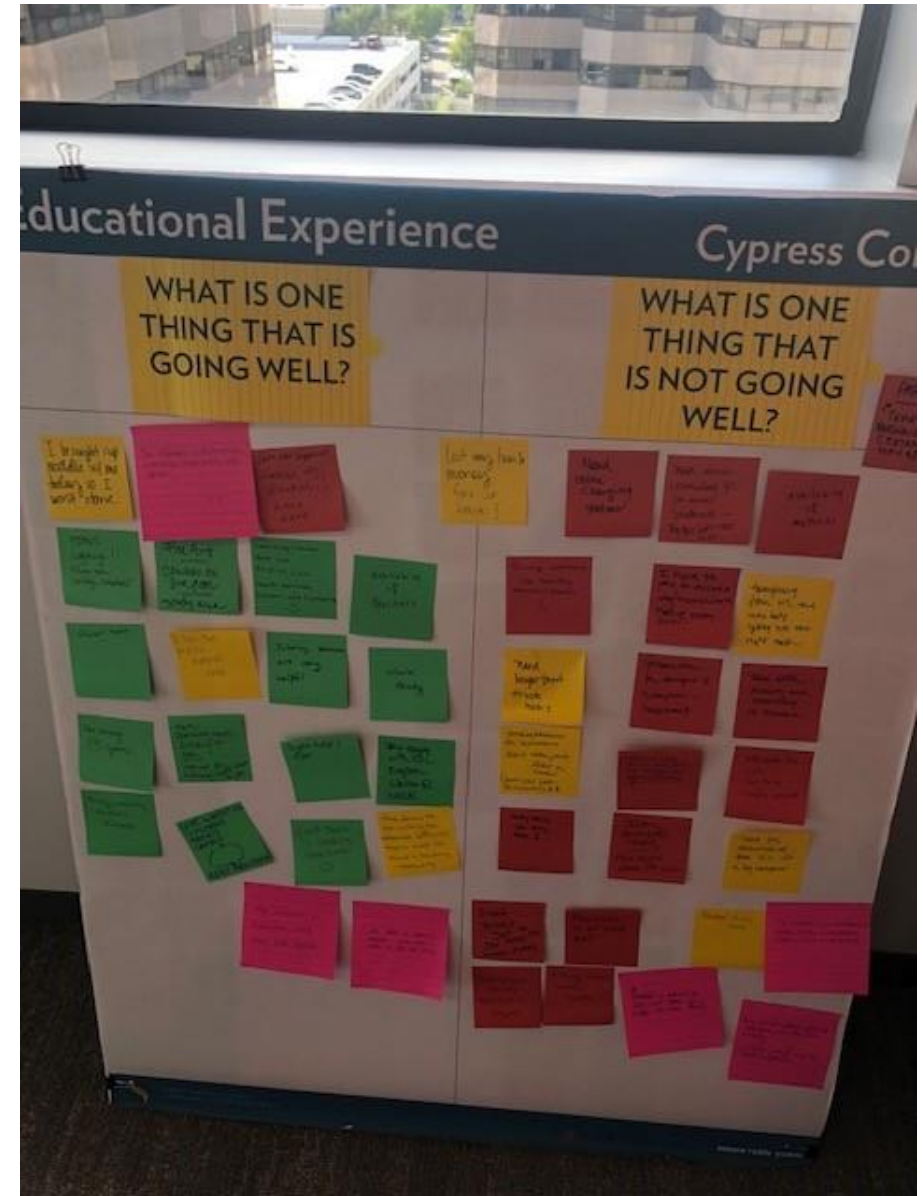
- › Classes don't transfer easily between Cypress and Fullerton; no one seems to know how to help

- › Clearer pathways or instructions on fulfilling degree requirements



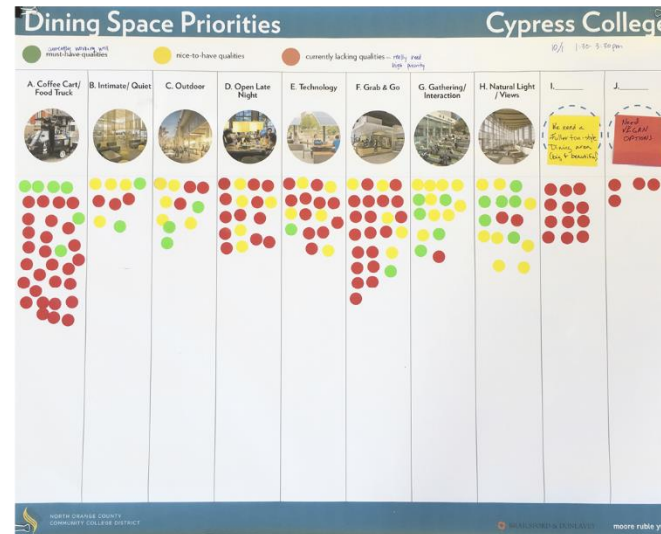
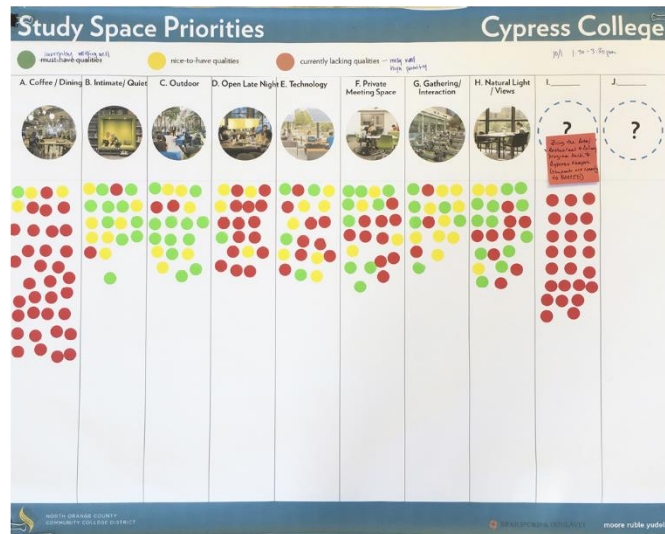
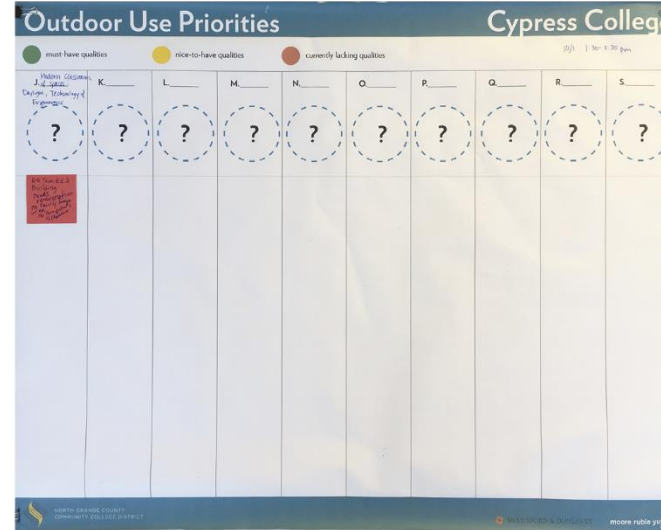
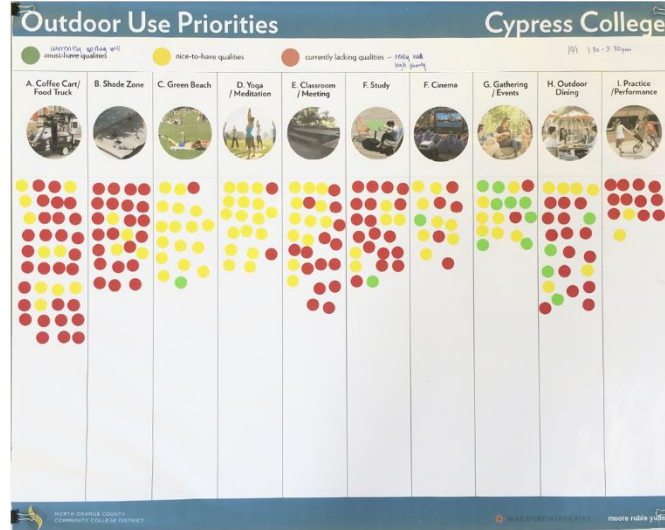
# Educational themes: Cypress

- › Administration is willing to tackle food and housing insecurity

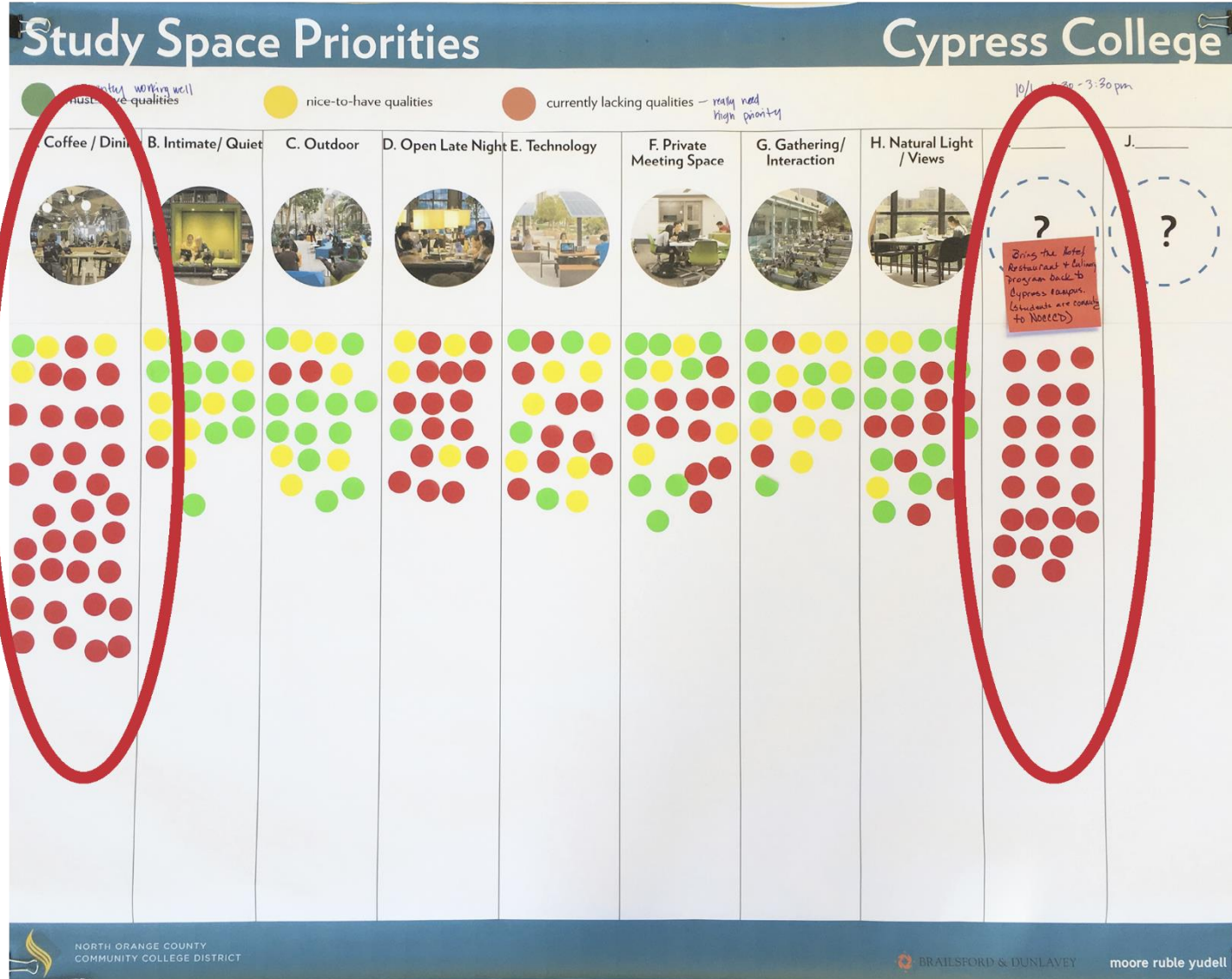

- › All student services should be available in one building or area so it's not so confusing





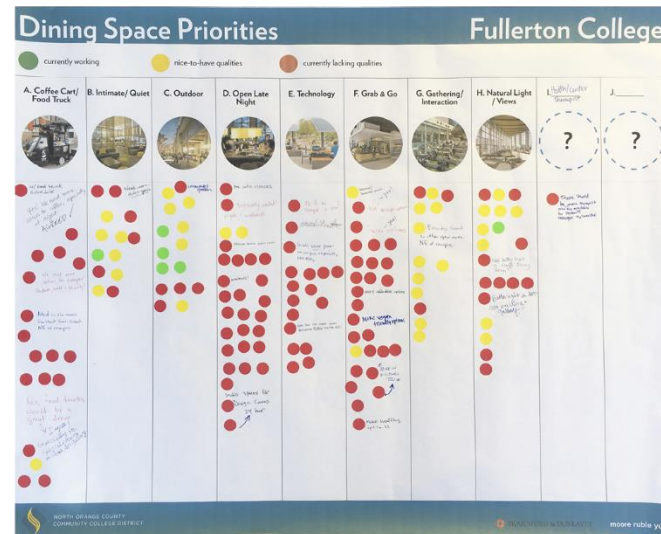
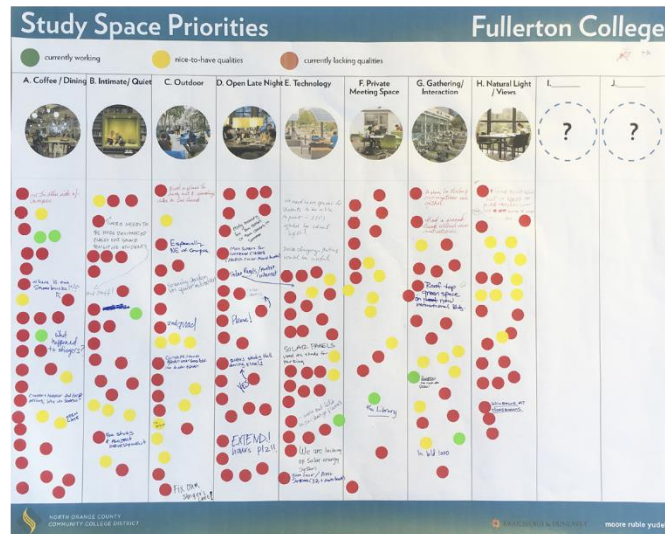
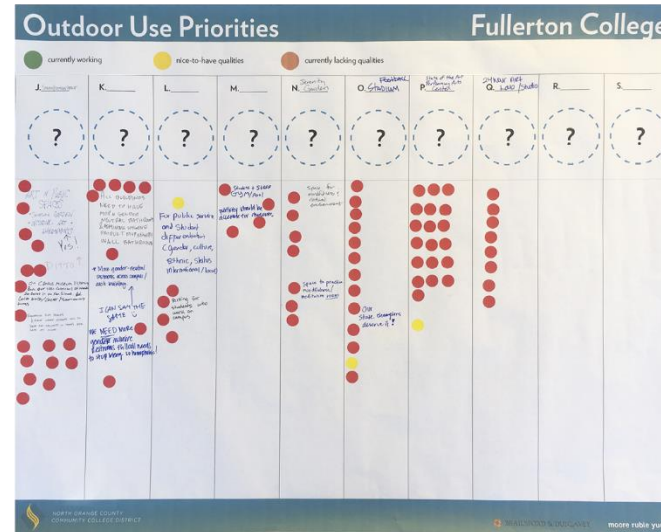
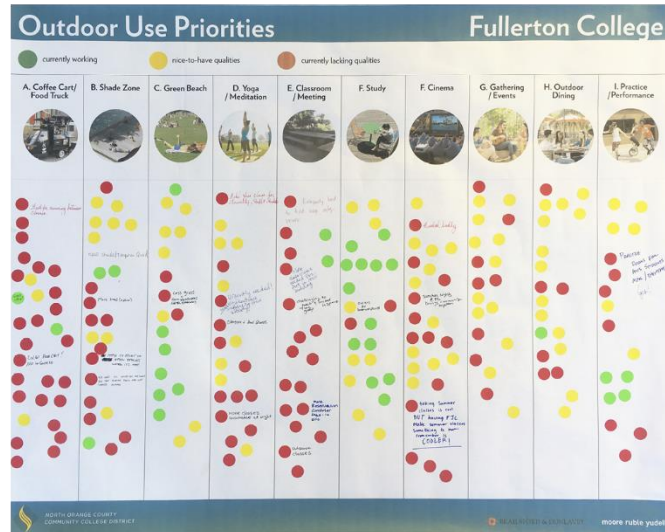

- › Beautiful maintenance of grounds; a beautiful campus

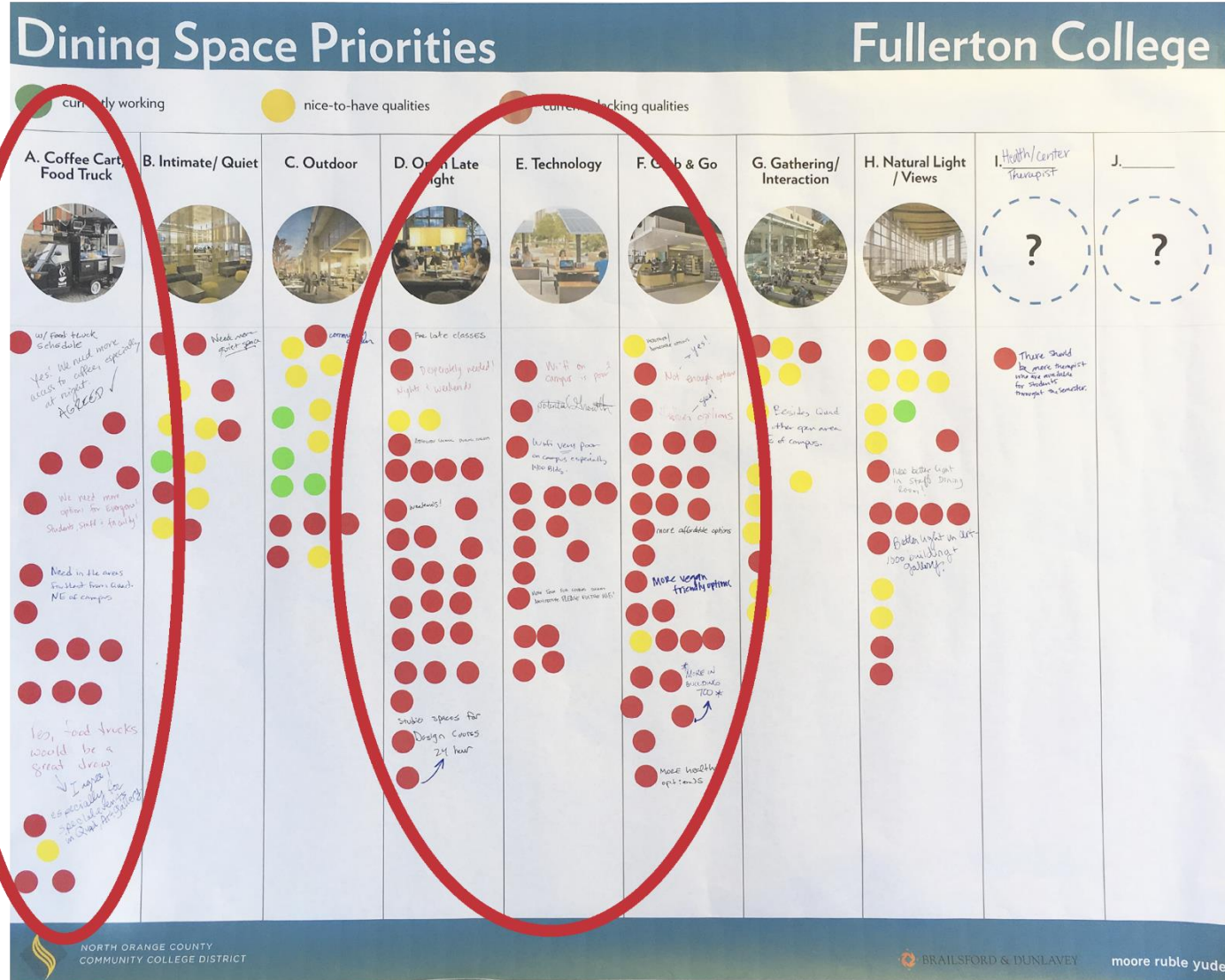

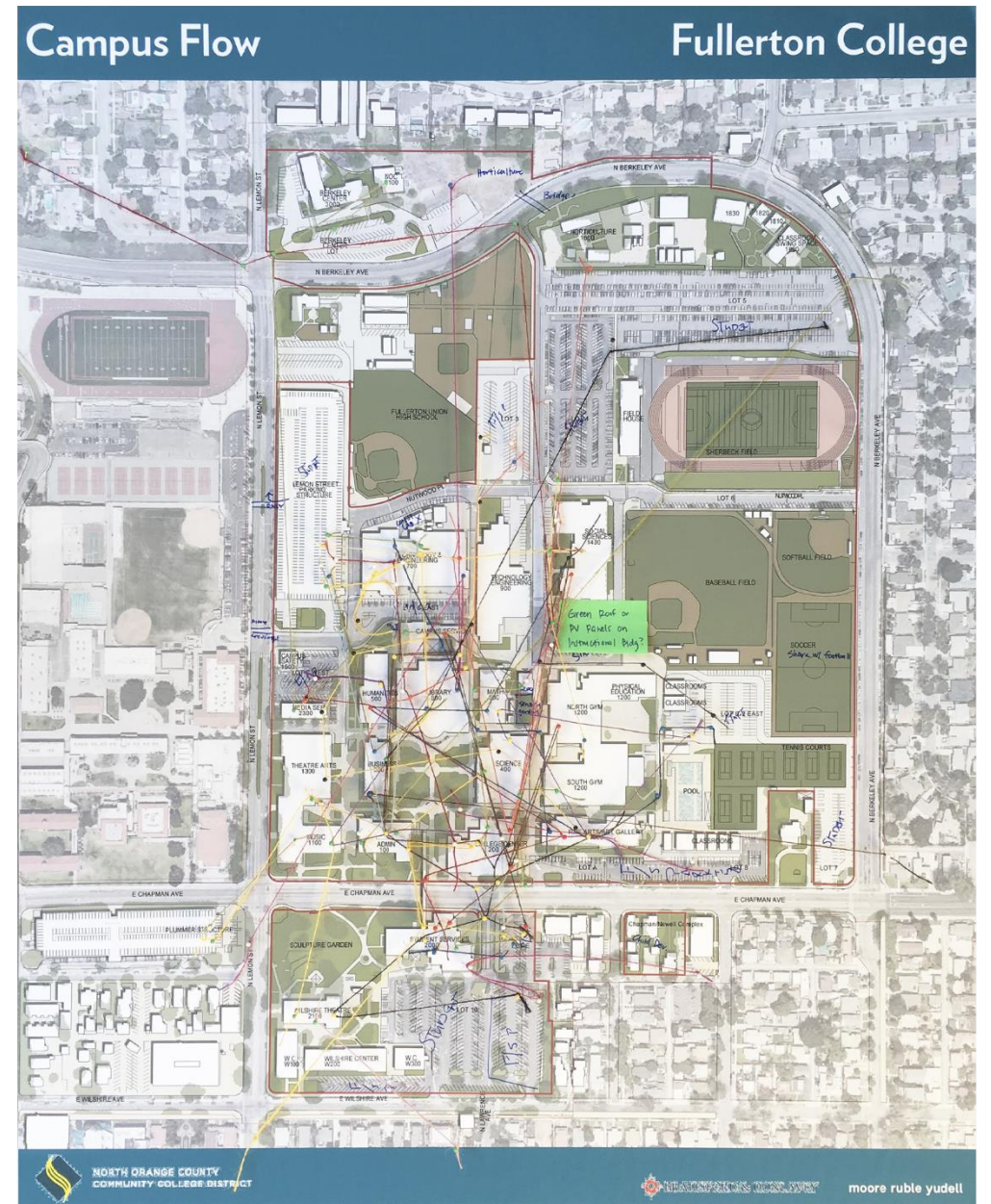

- › Updated equipment and more storage area for programs like Medical Assistant & Pharmacy Technician



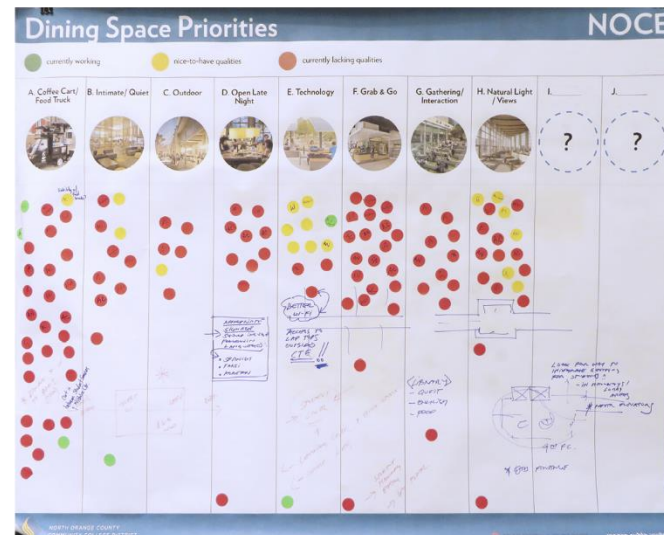
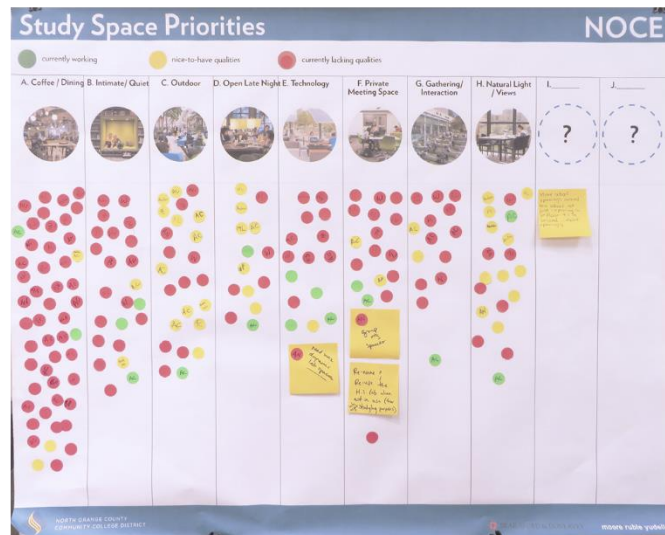
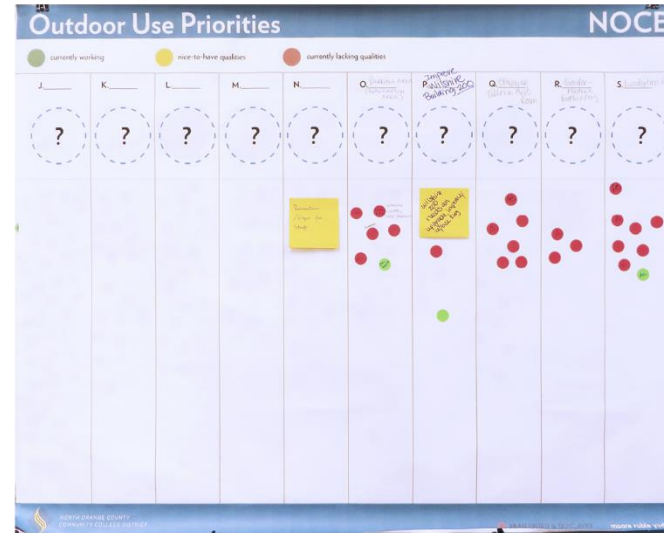
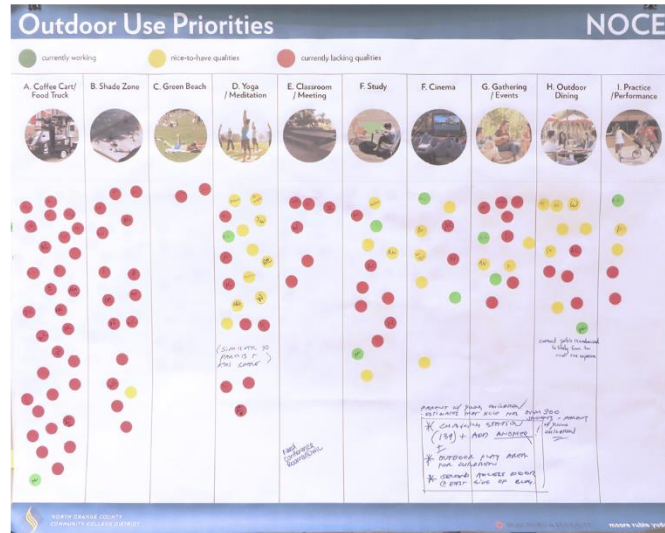
# Educational themes: NOCE
