**SUBJECT**: Public Hearing and Adoption of the Proposed

Budget FY 2015-2016

**BACKGROUND**: Pursuant to §58301 of Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations and in accordance with Board Policy 6200, Budget Preparation, the North Orange County Community College District (NOCCCD) shall hold a public hearing on the Proposed Budget prior to the Board adopting the budget. The 2015-2016 Proposed Budget is based on the best information available at the time of budget preparation. As such if future budget adjustments/revisions are needed after the preparation of the budget book, these adjustments will be brought to the Board for approval at a later date, as staff has done in the past.

This year's budget book, which accompanies this agenda, contains the following:

- General information, which contains organizational charts of all budget centers of the District. Also included in this section is the District's Financial Policies.
- Budget narrative, which explains the assumptions used to prepare the 2015-2016 Proposed Budget and a matrix identifying funds allocated to Strategic Directives with a General Fund Budget totaling \$304,168,091;
- General Fund Summary, which shows revenues and expenditures budgeted for 2015-2016 compared with 2014-2015 actuals, General Fund Summary by Fund Type, which shows the budgeted 2015-2016 categorized by Prior Year Funds, Current Year Funds, Self-Supporting Funds, and Categorical Funds;
- General Fund Ongoing Revenues and Expenses, which compare the 2014-2015 "ongoing" budgets against 2015-2016 Proposed Budget information. This schedule shows that NOCCCD has an ongoing deficit of \$260,154;
- General Fund Revenue Detail, which shows a line-item comparison between the estimated 2015-2016 revenues and 2014-2015 actuals;
- General Fund Summary by site, which shows the total General Fund expenditures categorized by District-wide, District Services, Information Services, Cypress College, Fullerton College, and the School of Continuing Education, including a narrative by budget center of budget priorities and planning items in accordance with the District-wide Strategic Plan;
- Current-year Grant Detail, which shows the Grant Budgets by site for the General, Child Development, and Financial Aid funds. Also, in this section is a short description of each of the grants;
- Analysis of the General Fund Ending Balances as of June 30, 2015, including a narrative by budget center of the use of carry-over funds;

- Comparison of the Proposed General Fund Budget with the preceding four fiscal years;
- Budget for Other District Funds, which shows the budget for the Bond Fund, Capital Outlay Fund, Child Development Fund, Financial Aid Fund, Retiree Benefit Fund, and the Self-Insurance Fund. Also, in this section is a listing of Bond and Capital Outlay projects;
- Budget for Auxiliary Funds, which shows the budget for Associated Students, Bookstores, Bursar Operations, Campus Services, Class Related Program Activities, Food Services, and Student Representation Fee;
- Hospitality expenditures for 2014-2015 and Hospitality budgets for 2015-2016; and
- CCFS-311 (Financial and Budget Report). This section also includes an explanation
  of the various sections of the report and the Gann Appropriation Limit. The Gann
  Appropriation Limit sets limitations of expenditures for state and local governments.
  For our District, the limitation is \$315,118,004 compared with our appropriations
  subject to the limit of \$190,798,710. This means our District's spending ability is
  \$124,319,294 under the limit.

In addition, Fullerton College Child Care Grants totaling \$94,737 which are included in this Proposed Budget, require a formal resolution be adopted by the Board. This resolution is to certify agreements with the California Department of Education to provide child care and development services to low-income children and their families, and to update facilities and equipment in the child care center. This agenda item was submitted by Rodrigo Garcia, District Director, Fiscal Affairs.

How does this relate to the five District Strategic Directions? This item responds to Direction #4: The District will implement best practices related to planning including: transparent decision-making processes, support of strategic and comprehensive planning activities at campus and District levels, and the allocation of resources to fund planning priorities.

**How does this relate to Board Policy**: This item is submitted in accordance with Board Policy 6200, Budget Preparation.

**FUNDING SOURCE AND FINANCIAL IMPACT**: After Board approval of the 2015-2016 Proposed Budget, the budget balances will be rolled into Banner and will become the Operating Budget for the fiscal year. Any subsequent budget transfers requiring Board approval and/or budget adjustments/revisions will be brought forward separately.

**RECOMMENDATION**: It is recommended that after the public hearing the Board adopt the 2015-2016 Proposed Budget with a General Fund Budget totaling \$304,168,091 and associated funds as summarized in the Proposed Budget Book. It is further requested that the Board approve the Gann Appropriation Limit, which is \$315,118,004. In addition, it is recommended that the Board adopt a resolution to certify the approval of entering into agreements and any amendments with the California Department of Education and to authorize the Vice Chancellor, Finance & Facilities, or the District Director, Fiscal Affairs, to sign contract documents for fiscal year 2015-2016.

**BACKGROUND**: On April 28, 2015, the Board approved to enter into an agreement with R<sup>2</sup>A Architecture (R<sup>2</sup>A) to provide design development, construction documents, construction administration and DSA certification services for the 2,486 square feet 1<sup>st</sup> floor warehouse area of the Anaheim Campus. As part of the design efforts, the structural engineer reviewed the current 2013 California Building Code (CBC) and found that the existing 2,000 psi concrete slab-on-grade does not meet the minimum 2,500 psi concrete strength requirements. Further due diligence done by the structural engineer indicated the existing slab was constructed of unreinforced (no rebar) concrete. As the site is in a High Seismic Design Category "D," the existing plain unreinforced concrete slab is not permitted by Code and, therefore, needs to be removed and replaced. R<sup>2</sup>A was, therefore, requested to provide expanded structural engineering design services for the replacement of the existing concrete slab. The expanded scope will include:

- additional design for a new concrete slab-on grade to replace the existing concrete slab and for the associated detailing to support the existing storage racks; and
- additional design and detailing for seismic anchorage of the existing storage racks

R<sup>2</sup>A proposes to provide the additional services for a fixed fee of \$3,913. It is, therefore, requested that the agreement with R<sup>2</sup>A be amended and the contract amount increased by \$3,913 from \$46,423 to \$50,336. All other terms of the agreement shall remain the same. This agenda item was submitted by Richard Williams, District Director, Facilities Planning & Construction.

**BACKGROUND**: On May 1, 2015, the District received responses to the Request for Qualifications for Program Management Services from eight companies: Facilities Planning & Program Services, Inc.; Hill International, Inc.; Cordoba Corporation; Gafcon, Inc.; Harris & Associates, Inc.; Cumming Construction Management, Inc.; MAAS Companies, Inc.; and Brailsford & Dunlavey. Of the eight companies that submitted responses, six companies were interviewed by the Selection Committee, which was comprised of District and campus staff. Ultimately, MAAS Companies, Inc. (MAAS) was selected by the District, with concurrence from campus staff, to provide program

management services for the implementation of the Measure J Bond Program and overall

capital improvements within the District.

MAAS is a comprehensive, planning and management company specializing in services to educational institutions including community colleges, colleges/universities (public and private), elementary and secondary school districts, cities and counties. Working with key project stakeholders, MAAS guides projects from initial programming, through critical phasing and funding procedures, and into Design, Bidding, Construction, Start-Up and Operations. Their scope of services will function as staff augmentation and shall include, but not limited to, program-wide management, design consultant selection; design management; bid management; construction management, if required; post-construction and occupancy management; project finance; and sustainability; MAAS has the experience and capability to manage construction projects structured in a variety of delivery methods, such as Design/Build, Design/Bid/Build, CM Multiple-Prime and CM-at-Risk.

The purpose of this agenda item is to provide information on the selection process, discuss the staffing augmentation needs of the District and clarify the anticipated contract scope of the program management services. Although MAAS is capable of providing full-service program management services, the District desires instead to narrow the contract scope to simply augment current or future District staff. This method of program management will minimize unnecessary and duplicative efforts and costs. This agenda item was submitted by Richard Williams, District Director, Facilities Planning & Construction.
