BP 5700 Intercollegiate Athletics

Title IX, Education Amendments of 1972; Education Code Sections 66271.6, 66271.8, 67360, et seq., and 78223 20 U.S. Code Sections 1681 et seq.; ACCJC Accreditation Standard II.C.4; WASC/ACS Criterion 2, Indicator 2.4

- 1.0 Intercollegiate athletics programs are aligned with the District and colleges' missions, and contribute to the social and cultural dimensions of the educational experience of students. They shall be conducted with sound educational policy and standards of integrity.
- 2.0 The District is committed to the value of gender equity for both men and women in intercollegiate athletics and shall act affirmatively to assure gender equity in the quality and quantity of participation in athletics.
- 3.0 The District may maintain an organized program for men and women in intercollegiate athletics. The program shall not discriminate on the basis of gender in the availability of athletic opportunities.
- 4.0 The Chancellor or designee shall assure that the athletics program complies with the California Community College Athletic Association (CCCAA) Constitution and Sport Championship Handbooks, and appropriate Conference Constitution regarding student athlete participation.
