

Additional Information
December 10, 2019 Board Meeting

The following additional information was provided regarding the December 10 Board meeting agenda:

Item 4.a: Purchase Orders and Checks:

1. P0136224: What's the context of the catering of the Jump Start at Dale Jr. High? **The goal of the Jump Start program is to create awareness among students regarding higher education and career paths. Local junior high and high schools bring students for a field trip to Fullerton College where they participate in a campus tour, Kuder career and personality assessment, and hear various presentations that promote higher education and career awareness. Dale Junior High sent 96 students over a 2 day period. The catering was to provide lunch for the students on campus.**
2. P0136351: Is this a reimbursement? **This is for membership to the California Automotive Teachers association that promotes the best interests of automotive instruction throughout the state of California. Each year, several Automotive faculty from Fullerton College attend the association's Southern California conference to gain technical knowledge in the field.**

Item 5.a, Cypress College Curriculum:

1. Page 5.a.9: Does CIP stand for Classification of Instructional Programs? **CIP is an IPEDs designation and stands for Classification of Instructional Programs which is used for accurate tracking and reporting of fields of study and program completion activity.**
2. Page 5.a.13: What does "FSA" stand for in the Nursing 193 C? **FSA stands for Faculty Service Area and delineates the designated education requirement for teaching in a specific discipline within the community colleges.**

Item 5.b, Fullerton College Curriculum:

1. Page 5.b.12: When was the CSPRD last updated? **The CSPRD was approved by DCCC in Spring 2007. It has not been modified since that date, but it is used constantly and discussed every time courses are reviewed or proposed.**
2. Page 5.b.21: What does TOPS stand for? **TOPS stands for "Taxonomy of Programs."**
